Judy Wimmer, Director of Share the Harvest updated Kiwanis members this week. Share the Harvest is located in Greenview. It is the only Camden County source for state/federal commodities for families that qualify. 1,056 turkeys were given during the recent holidays.

Ten years ago, STH was just a dream and then opened in a tiny shed helping 100 families. No longer operating out of a shed, in 2015 we are providing food to 1,000 families per month working out of a very large new building.

Checks totaling almost \$5,000 were presented to help support day to day operations, food and growth of this important agency that helps feed Camden County families.
