Lake Regional Hospital serves 33,000 in the Emergency Room in 2014.

Thousands of those ER visits are for scared and injured children. Kiwanis & Christmas for Kids is proud to donate \$3900 this week to purchase iPads for the ER to calm and occupy kids prior to procedures to fix their boo boo! The iPads have special apps that show the kids info about the procedure they will be experiencing and what to expect in the hospital.

Terri Hall, Director of Fund Development, accepted the check on behalf of the hospital and shared with Kiwanis that **Christmas for Kids has donated over \$50,000 total to the Hospital over the years.** Terri Hall is also a Kiwanis member and helps us raise the money. (thank you)

Kiwanis members learned some impressive updates about our hospital serving the community...For example... at Lake Regional the average time is only 8 minutes average time to be seen by a healthcare provider in the ER....where the statewide average is 27 minutes.....

Other examples include the quick treatment of heart attack and stroke victims. Many stroke victims presenting at Lake Regional have had damage reversed by the use of tpa therapy in the ER long before they could have been transported to a larger regional hospital...very important for a retirement aged population.

Ozark Coast Kiwanis is one of the largest service organizations at the Lake. All funds raised go back to the Lake Community to support dozens of children focused programs that depend on Kiwanis to fund and run their programs.
