Did you know?...Lake Ozark Fire Protection District

- Covers 42 square miles
- 4 fire stations (3 staffed & 1 for training)
- plus a Marine Division to assist with water front fires
- averages 1,200+ emergency calls per year.
- Runs Mutual Aid calls to neighboring districts especially right across the Community Bridge

Kids Programs & Community Service

- Has 5 Certified car seat installers and donate 100 car seats per year
- Teach safe boating and donate life jackets for kids
- Safe Sitter Courses for ages 13 and up...includes CPR training
- Teaches Safe Kids for younger kids
- Shop With A Fireman at Christmas for kids that would not otherwise have a Christmas

Kiwanis' donations to the Fire Department are focused on the kids programs but there are lots of other needs that your donations can help...i.e. each new ladder truck costs between \$500,000 - \$1,000,000. Ozark Coast Kiwanis is one of the largest service organizations at the Lake. All funds raised go back to the Lake Community to support dozens of children focused programs that depend on Kiwanis to fund and run their programs.
