MCBC combines the fun of summer camp with the life skills and support needed to move beyond the trauma of burns. Children ages 6-17 can attend a week-long camp which takes place at the beautiful Camp Sabra at the Lake of the Ozarks.

Burns Recovered was established in 1983 by a group of burn survivors with assistance from the burn care team at St. John’s Mercy Medical Center in St. Louis, MO.
