Every year Wonderland Camp serves approximately 1,000 summer campers!

Since 1969, Wonderland Camp has provided a fun, educational summer camp experience for children, teenagers, and adults who have disabilities. An individualized experience is created for every camper who visits Wonderland Camp at the Lake of the Ozarks.

From their small start of a couple of buildings, the facilities at Wonderland Camp have continued to grow thanks to donors and charitable organizations.

Wonderland Camp charges \$650 per camper to attend camp for the week. With costs at \$1000 per camper, that leaves them \$350 short. They rely on donations from the local community to cover the gap.

A check for \$3500 from Kiwanis was presented to Wonderland Camp to help bridge-the-gap for some lucky campers this summer!
