Lake Ozark Fire Protection District (LOFPD) is one of four large Lake Area Fire Districts... Lake Ozark has four fire houses and answered 1200 emergency calls last year.

LOFPD has witnessed many accidents that caused injury to kids that either were not in a car seat or the car seat was not properly installed. In order to reduce these incidents and educate the public LOFPD will install car seats for free and sometimes even provide a new car seat if an older/less safe car seat was brought in for installation.

Mark Amsinger, Chief, LOFPD and member of Ozark Coast Kiwanis provided an update on LOFPD annual activity and was presented a \$300 check to help purchase additional car seats.
