Ron Estep, Executive Director of Helping Hands, shared with Kiwanis members an overview of 2015 activities serving over 250 men women and children.

Lake Area Helping Hands Homeless Shelter provides temporary and emergency shelter and transitional housing for homeless men, women, children and families in Camdenton and surrounding areas. Helping Hands provides a safe environment for residents to live in while seeking employment, saving money and receiving the counseling needed to become independent.

Helping Hands Thrift Store is located 4 miles south of Camdenton on Hwy 5. The Thrift Store proceeds help provide food and shelter to 40 individuals every night....The Thrift Store is open 9 to 4 Tues, Thurs, Fri & Saturday. New, unique and rare items are arriving daily.
