Builders Club is a service focused club sponsored by Ozark Coast Kiwanis at Osage Middle School. The student-led organization provides members with opportunities to perform service, build character and develop leadership. Members help their community throughout the school year. Local Lake of the Ozark projects include the Mobile Food Bank, Christmas Bell Ringing at Walmart, Thanksgiving Food Drive, visiting Nursing Home residents and in 2015 a 2 month long shoe drive for the **Shoeman Water Project...a St. Louis founded charity.**

The 6th and 7th grade students collected 1900 pairs of shoes. These shoes are sold to a bulk exporter that then provides funds to finance a clean water projects. To date several wind driven water well digging and aqueduct water filter systems have been built in five Central America developing countries and Kenya in Africa.

Shoe collection locations through May 12th included ...Faithbridge Church, Harper Chapel, Shane Landis Insurance, Central Bank and Greenview Baptist Church. Lake Fishing Tackle donated boxes for drop-off points.
