Did you know children under the age of 7 years must wear a personal flotation device at all times unless confined in a fully enclosed area? This is just one of the basic Missouri boating laws.

To serve as a local source for boating and water safety information for the general public, The Lake of the Ozarks Water Safety Council was formed in 2007. You or someone you know may have worn a life jacket to work earlier this year or you may be familiar with the catchphrase “Think Before You Sink.” These campaigns were developed to increase water safety awareness while recreating at the Lake of the Ozarks.

To keep the Lake of the Ozarks fun and safe for everyone, boaters are encouraged to have proper-fitting life jackets, and an electrical inspection on their dock. At participating waterfront restaurants, designated captains can receive a kit containing a key chain, which is good for a free soda during their visit.

To promote its water safety campaigns, Lake of the Ozarks Water Safety Council must seek donations from charitable organizations.

A check for \$500 from Kiwanis was presented to Lake of the Ozarks Water Safety Council to assist with the purchase of life jackets.
